## WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE?

### • *Functional cookies*

Our "functional" cookies ensure that the website works well. For example, these cookies remember your language preference.

### • *Analytical cookies*

We use Google Analytics to track how visitors use the website, this data helps us to continuously improve the user experience. For this purpose, privacy friendly cookies from Google Analytics are placed.

## SOCIAL MEDIA BUTTONS

On our website we have also included buttons from social media channels on which we are active. These buttons work via pieces of code that originate from, for example, Facebook and Twitter itself. Cookies are placed by means of this code. We have no influence over this.
